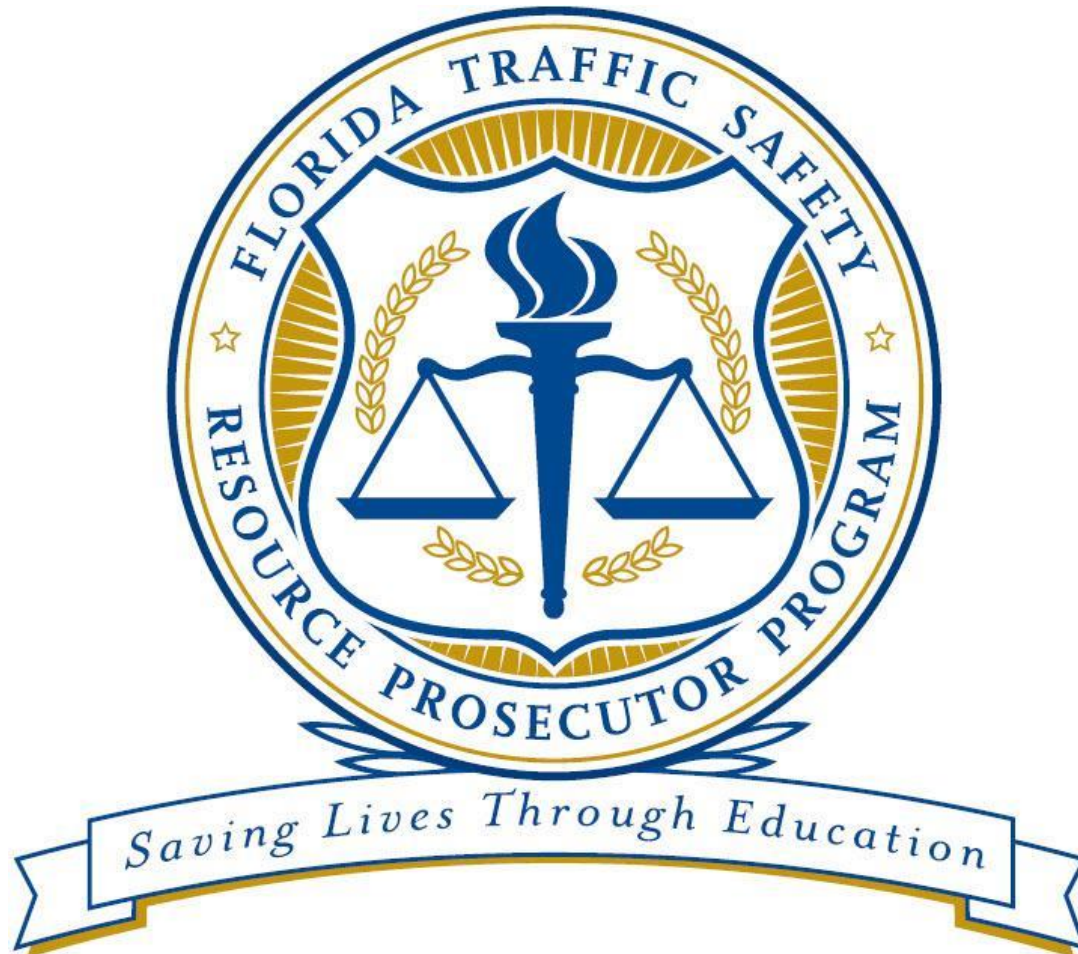

Serve as a statewide resource that provides training, education, and technical support to prosecutors and law enforcement officers to enhance DUI enforcement and prosecution.

What Can the Florida TSRP Do for You?

- **Training** – The Florida TSRP Program Conducts the following seminars annually:
 - Basic DUI Trial Advocacy (*5 days*)
 - Advanced DUI Trial Advocacy (*2 days*)
 - Prosecuting the Drugged Driver (*2 days*)
 - DUI/Vehicular Manslaughter (*2 days*)
 - SAO In-House Training
 - Basic DUI Case Law (4-hours)
 - Implied Consent Issues (2-hours)



What Can the Florida TSRP Do for You?

- **LEO Specific Training** – The Florida TSRP Program Conducts the following LEO Specific Training:
 - Basic DUI Trial Preparation (*1 day*)
 - Read-Off Training – *Available in-house upon request*
 - *DUI Basics – 1-hr*
 - *Legal Background & Basics for SFSTs – 2-hr*
 - *Implied Consent: Breath, Urine & Blood – 2-hr*

- **Technical Assistance** – The Florida TSRP Program will provide technical assistance, upon request for numerous DUI and Traffic Safety issues, including:
 - Initial Case Analysis & Assistance
 - Legal Research Assistance
 - Policy Review and Revision
